Jan C. Guy SCHOLARSHIP FOR A **FEMALE** WITH FINANCIAL NEED

BACKGROUND

The Santa Ana/Tustin Soroptimist International Scholarship is presented annually by the Soroptimist Club of Santa Ana/Tustin to a graduating Santa Ana Unified School District **FEMALE** student who is in financial need. Currently the award will be a minimum of \$500 and is to be used by the awardee as needed, while pursuing higher education.

PURPOSE

This scholarship is administrated by the Soroptimist International of Santa Ana-Tustin Club directly. This award is given to a SAUSD graduating **FEMALE** student who best meets the following criteria:

1. The student(s) shall be **FEMALE** from the Santa Ana Unified School District with financial need.
2. The student(s) shall have maintained at least a 2.0 grade point average.
3. The student(s) shall carry at least 9 credits at an accredited college in the fall semester following graduation.

In addition, the student(s) shall submit a 200-300 word essay on **“What a college education means to me in addition to the obstacles I have faced to graduate.”**

SELECTION PROCESS

The Soroptimist SAUSD selection committee will make the annual selection.

RECIPIENT(S)

Proof of full-time enrollment documents are required to be submitted by recipient before check is issued.
